## AWARDS FOR ALL!



The Craigiebank Association has been awarded £5000 by Awards for All - an awards agency funded by the National Lottery. The money has been awarded for improvements to the large hall within Craigiebank Parish Church to make it more suitable for community activities.

The money is being spent on a new audio system for the hall, including loudspeakers with an induction loop system for hard-of-hearing visitors, as well as other audio-visual facilities. These new facilities will fit the hall for use for any form of large gatherings, from public meetings to conferences to concerts. The audio-visual system will be portable, and so also available for use in the smaller hall or in the church itself.

The Association plans to christen the new facilities later in the year by holding an evening of local nostalgia, based around a collection of local photographs and films taken by the late George Black, a resident of Craigiebank for many years - for more details, see the "What's On" listing on page 3.

# YOUR SPACE IN CRAIGIEBANK

The two halls within Craigiebank Parish Church buildings are an excellent local resource for club and family activities, including sports clubs, parties, meetings and concerts. Already there are more than a dozen organisations for all ages using our premises on a regular basis, and we are also able to take bookings for occasional activities or one-offs such as children's parties. If your organisation requires premises, or you are looking to start a new organisation in the Craigiebank area, *just let us know!*



The small hall is ideal for meetings of up to 20 people - a blackboard, whiteboard and screen are available. The large hall can seat up to 140 for concerts or dances, and many sports can be accommodated too. A low stage is available at one end of the room. Twenty light-but-sturdy folding tables are available, together with brand-new light and convenient folding chairs.



Both halls are convenient for the kitchen area, with food preparation surfaces, cooker (with grill and oven), fridge, dishwasher and hot water urn.

Additional facilities including our new audio-visual system (see page 1) and an electric piano are available by special request. Another small room can be made available for meetings of up to ten people, and the main church can be booked for special events, such as organ recitals.

- **Large Hall** - £15 per hour - *Concerts / Children's Parties / Dances / Sports / Fundraising Events*
- **Small Hall** - £5 per hour - *Meetings / Presentations / Small Gatherings*
- **Meeting Room** - £5 per hour - *Small meetings*
- **Kitchen** - £5 per hour
